### **How Long Does It Take to Digest Food?**

Stool, or waste left over from the digestion procedure, is gone through the colon by methods of peristalsis, first in a liquid state and ultimately in a solid type. As stool travels through the colon, water is gotten rid of. Stool is stored in the sigmoid (S-shaped) colon until a "mass motion" clears it into the anus once or twice a day.

The time passing through the large intestine is much longer, averaging about 40 hours. For men, the average time to digest food is shorter overall than it is for women. Having a digestive condition that affects transit time (the time it takes for food to pass through the digestive system) can shorten or extend the time.

### **Your Digestive System and How it Works**

After you eat, it takes about six to eight hours for food to pass through your stomach and small intestine. Food then enters your large intestine (colon) for further digestion, absorption of water and, finally, elimination of undigested food. It takes about 36 hours for food to move through the entire colon.
