Clean your headphone jack. Use a toothpick to gently remove any debris from the headphone jack. Debris in the headphone jack (lint, etc.) will prevent a connection between the iPod and the headphones or charger cable. If the jack is clear but the Shuffle won't sync, try using a different USB port to sync or charge.
