If you set the gutter to, say, 2 inches, then all text will be moved that far to the right (for odd pages) and to the left (if you have even and odd pages). That's not what you need.

On the File menu, click Page Setup, and then click the Margins tab. In the Gutter box, enter a value for the gutter margin. In the Gutter position box, click Left, or Top. You should click Left, if you plan to bind the document at the left or right side or click Top, if you plan to bind the document at the top side.

But in cases where a portion of the page (usually the left or top edge) will be hidden, the margins of the Word document must take this into account. Word provides two ways to provide for binding, both found on the Margins tab of the Page Setup dialog: the Gutter setting in the Margins area and the Mirror margins setting in the Multiple pages dropdown. They can be used in concert but in some situations are mutually exclusive.

Margins for Bound Documents

Every page has three outside margins (top, bottom, and side) and one inside margin (also called the gutter). Margins ensure your text isn't cut off during manufacturing. Set your page size before you set your margins. Why? Margin size depends on page count and on whether you have elements that bleed. See this chart to find your margin size:
