You are writing a news report for the radio, not for a medical journal. Use simple terms but do not repeat words. Your audience is the general public, not a lecture hall at Harvard. This is also to ensure that a radio reporter or announcer who will read your report will be able to pronounce all the words correctly and easily. Keep your sentences brief.

People watching TV or listening to the radio generally don't have time to check a dictionary. So keep your sentences simple and use basic, easily understood words. If you find you've put a longer word in a sentence, replace it with a shorter one.
