Modelling includes methods for calculating op risk capital requirements. Under Basel II, large banks were permitted to model their own operational risk capital using the advanced measurement approach (AMA). This sophisticated model incorporates four data elements: internal loss data, external data, scenario analysis, and business environment and ...
