Re-scribing panel lines... the very term can make even the most experienced modelers cringe. The molds used for the Italeri 1:48 P40M-N: Kittyhawk Mk4 are the old AMT/ERTL ones and show some deterioration due to age. The fuselage is not to well formed and requires some remedial work; sanding filling and re-scribing of panel lines.

### Scribing Panel Lines on Model Airplane Kits - WW2 Model ...

For making perfect panel lines this tool is far better than a needle tool or a scriber or an exact knife. It's designed specifically for scribing panel lines in plastic - nothing else. It follows a straight edge without scratching or cutting into your ruler. Two light passes and your panel line is done. Try three or four for more prominent lines.

Cut a strip long enough to go around your model's fuselage; cut this strip in half with scissors somewhat raggedly along its length; remove the protective backing from the half strip so that the tape's adhesive is exposed; and apply the half strip of tape around your fuselage so that its straight edge is where you want the desired panel line.

### **Tech Tips: Scribing Panel Lines - Tsohost**

A particularly difficult task in scribing plastic model airplanes is getting neat and parallel circumferential fuselage panel lines (i.e., panel lines that go \*around\* the fuselage), because it's very difficult to hold a metal straight edge at the correct location, and it can be difficult to avoid "waves" and "wiggles" if you apply strips of masking tape as a guide.

Panel Line scribing : A lot of model kits come in a pretty basic design. Many No Grade, High Grade, and some of the older Master Grades, have next to no details. Newer kits have an abundance of panel lines intersecting large parts of armour which breaks up the boring look of an otherwise featureless piece.

### **Best tape for scribing panel lines : modelmakers**

Squadron's scribing tool is a good choice for your scribing needs. I use it to rescribe panel lines on my aircraft models. The scribing point removes a thin layer of plastic as you draw it across the surface instead of pushing the plastic out of the way like knife blades or pointed objects. Good quality and a good price.

This is a great idea that makes positioning a scribing tape along panel lines or other surface details much easier than with tapes that are opaque. Once applied and burnished down, this tape doesn't move. The material is slick and exhibits very little friction with metal scribes allowing for no resistance during scribing.
