Litmus paper is filter paper which has been treated with a natural water-soluble dye obtained from lichens. The resulting piece of paper, called "litmus paper", can be used as a pH indicator. Blue litmus paper turns red under acidic conditions ( pH below 4.5) while red litmus paper turns blue under alkaline conditions ( pH above 8.3).

Light Blue litmus paper turns red under acidic conditions and red litmus paper turns blue under basic or alkaline conditions, with the color change occurring over the pH range 4.5-8.3 at 25 °C (77 °F). Neutral litmus paper is purple. Litmus can also be prepared as an aqueous solution that functions similarly.

Litmus paper is used to test the pH balance of a liquid or substance. Most substances are either alkali or acid. Alkaline, or basic, chemicals include baking soda, ammonia and lye. Acidic substances include vinegar, lemon juice and battery acid. Alkalies and acids are at opposite extremes chemically, and will cancel each other out to form a neutral substance when mixed together at equal strengths.

### **What Is the Difference Between Blue & Red Litmus Paper ...**

Litmus, mixture of coloured organic compounds obtained from several species of lichens that grow in the Netherlands, particularly *Lecanora tartarea* and *Rocella tinctorum*. Litmus turns red in acidic solutions and blue in alkaline solutions and is the oldest and most commonly used indicator of whether a substance is an acid or a base.
